Epidemiologist/Post-doc

The Division of Cancer Epidemiology has positions available for two highly motivated postdoctoral scientists to join an international research team investigating various aspects of gynecologic cancer risk and early detection.

Your tasks:

The postdoctoral scientist for the first position will focus on etiologic studies, as well as ovarian cancer early detection. These studies will be conducted within the EPIC cohort and a newly formed international ovarian cancer early detection consortium. The postdoc will be responsible for data analysis, preparation of scientific publications and reports, presentation of study results, project management, and will also be involved in the preparation of follow-up grant applications.

The second position is for a postdoctoral scientist to work on a World Cancer Research Fund (WCRF)-funded project to systematically review and summarize the literature on mechanisms underlying the association between body fatness and cancers of the breast, endometrium, and ovary in the style of the WCRF's well-established "Continuous Update Project" reviews. A background in clinical medicine, the biologic sciences, systems biology, or bioinformatics is highly desirable.

- PhD degree in epidemiology, biostatistics, or a related discipline
- Training in medicine or biological sciences
- Strong statistical evaluation and programming skills with SAS and/or R
- Record of first author scientific publications and excellent writing skills (fluency in English)
- Experience in epidemiological studies and methods
- Enthusiasm for epidemiological research in an international team

Contract period:

The position is limited to 2 years with the possibility of prolongation.

The position can in principle be part-time.

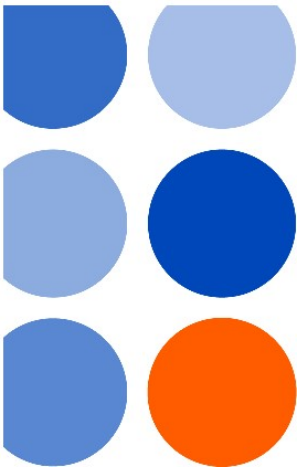
